AGM / President's Ball - November 2018 in Aarhus, Denmark

Patricia Mulvey MCIAT and Liam Cotter MCIAT will be attending the **AGM** as the elected voting delegates for the Republic of Ireland together with Councillor Michael O'Keeffe MCIAT. The **2019 CIAT AGM** will be held in Glasgow, Scotland.

There are four **Resolutions** which will be presented at the **AGM** for debate / discussion as follows: (1) Amendment to the Conduct and Disciplinary Procedures 2014; (2) Amendment to the Code of Conduct; (3) Amendment to the Bye-Laws (No.'s 11 & 12: Cessation of Membership); and (4) Amendment to the Bye Laws (No. 46: Council Voting). Each resolution will require a two-thirds majority at the AGM.

Technical Sub-committee

The **Technical Sub-committee** continues to meet monthly under the Chairmanship of Gillian Fletcher MCIAT. Below are some updates:

- The Technical Sub-Committee's submission on the draft amendments to TGD Parts L Dwellings and Part F Ventilation have been completed, submitted and acknowledged by the Department. There are a number of issues included in these draft relating to control of over-heating and sound break out from ducts which will affect the detail design of houses. Watch out for the publication of these amended documents.
- This committee is currently drafting a submission on "Public consultation on Urban Development and Building Heights draft Guidelines for Planning Authorities".
- The **Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2018** has been signed into law and will come into force in stages. This Act introduces among other items a Planning Regulator, increases the Vacant Site Levy, gives the Planning Authorities a greater role in Liquor Licensing and data centres will be considered "strategic infrastructure" developments" allowing direct applications to **An Bord Pleanala**.

Our **Technical Sub-Committee** would be grateful for any contributions from the general membership when we are working on future submissions or if any member becomes aware of difficult interpretations of legislation, changes to legislation or new legislation relating to the construction industry, please advise the **Technical Sub-Committee**.
