# Why we are doing this research

The Building Safety Regulator's (BSR's) Technical Policy team is planning an official review of the Approved Documents (ADs) – the statutory guidance documents that advise on how to meet the Building Regulations – which is expected to build on the findings of an Expert Group that was set up by the Government in line with a recommendation in Dame Judith Hackitt's Interim Report on Building Regulations and Fire Safety in 2020.

The Expert Group recommended the Government should carry out further research with the construction industry to understand who uses ADs, how they are used and where they are used. This will help to understand what guidance is used by the construction industry to comply with building regulation requirements, where ADs fit into this and what this means for the development of ADs in future.

The overall aim of this research is to understand perceptions of the ADs, any barriers to use and potential solutions. To achieve this, we are seeking input from a range of professionals with experience of working in different roles in the built environment.
